





# GRANTS REFRESH | PROCESS





Listened to grantee, Commissioner, and panelist feedback



Considered resources: number of grant panels, staff and volunteer time, use of state funds for travel and honorariums



Reviewed and analyzed grants, their historical application rates and allocations, impact on the Commonwealth of Virginia, guidelines, and policies



Asked the most important questions when considering grant programs: Is this applicant worthy of an investment from the state? Why? What is the impact?

# GRANTS REFRESH | BENEFITS



#### FOR GRANTEES

- Simplify our application and allocation processes
- Create clear entry points in which grantees can identify themselves / their needs
- Increase flexibility and adapt to needs of grant applicants
- Remove barriers for new and returning grantees



#### FOR PANELISTS

- Streamline review processes and reduce the number of grant panels so as not to overburden volunteers
- Utilize panelists' expertise for review of the most specific and highest dollar allocation

#### FOR VIRGINIANS

- Diversification of funds for deserving arts organizations, nonprofits, and artists across the Commonwealth
- Strong stewardship of state and federal tax dollars




### **VCA REGIONAL MAP**




